

MUNICH, AUG 21 (CMD)- RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER NICOLAE CEAUSESCU SAID JUST ONE WEEK AGO TODAY THAT "THERE CAN BE NO JUSTIFICATION FOR THE USE OF ARMED FORCES FOR INTERVENTION IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF ANY OF THE WARSAW TREATY MEMBER COUNTRIES."

CEAUSESCU WHO WAS SPEAKING AT THE BUCHAREST MILITARY ACADEMY THE DAY BEFORE HE FLEW TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA, FOR TALKS WITH THE LEADERSHIP SAID: "THE SETTLEMENT OF INTERNAL PROBLEMS BELONGS EXCLUSIVELY TO THE PARTIES AND PEOPLES OF EACH COUNTRY."

"INTERFERENCE OF ANY KIND CAN NOT BUT HARM THE CAUSE OF SOCIALISM, FRIENDSHIP AND CO-OPERATION AMONG THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES."

IN PRAGUE TWO DAYS LATER, ON AUGUST 16, HE TOLD A PRESS CONFERENCE THAT THE WARSAW PACT HAD BEEN CREATED TO DEFEND SOCIALISM AGAINST EXTERNAL AGGRESSION.

CEAUSESCU HAD BEEN TOLD THAT A POLISH GENERAL HAD EXPRESSED CONCERN AT CERTAIN PHENOMENA IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND HAD OFFERED POLISH SUPPORT TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY AND PEOPLE. THE JOURNALIST THEN ASKED CEAUSESCU TO CLARIFY WHEN IT WAS POSSIBLE WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE WARSAW PACT TO GO TO THE AID OF ANOTHER FRATERNAL COUNTRY.

CEAUSESCU SAID: "IN THIS RESPECT THE WARSAW TREATY IS VERY CLEAR. THERE IS NO NEED FOR ANY CLARIFICATION. THE TREATY IS CREATED TO PREVENT AN ATTACK FROM THE SIDE OF AN IMPERIALIST COUNTRY AGAINST SOME MEMBER COUNTRY."

CEAUSESCU BEGAN EXPRESSING HIS PARTY'S OPEN SUPPORT FOR CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN A SERIES OF PUBLIC SPEECHES IN MID-JULY. THE RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY NEWSPAPER SCIENTEIA ALSO PUBLISHED EDITORIALS IN SUPPORT OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK POSITION.

IN ONE OF HIS EARLIEST PUBLIC EXPRESSIONS OF SUPPORT, CEAUSESCU TOLD THOUSANDS OF WORKERS AT BRAILA ON JULY 16 "THE RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY AND THE RUMANIAN PEOPLE EXPRESS THEIR CONFIDENCE IN AND COMPLETE SOLIDARITY WITH THE FRATERNAL CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE AND WITH ITS COMMUNIST PARTY, BEING CONVINCED THAT UNDER COMMUNIST LEADERSHIP, THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE WILL KNOW HOW TO REPEL ANY ATTEMPT WHICH STRIKES AT THE INTERESTS OF SOCIALISM AND ANY BLOW AGAINST ITS FREEDOM, THEREBY ENSURING SOCIALISM'S PROGRESS TOWARD FINAL VICTORY IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

HIS MOST RECENT EXPRESSION OF SUPPORT WAS ONLY YESTERDAY WHEN IN AN ADDRESS IN THE INDUSTRIAL CITY OF PITESTI, 100 KM WEST OF BUCHAREST, HE SAID. THAT "THE FATE OF SOCIALISM, THE FATE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE IS SAFE IN THE HANDS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY LEADERSHIP."

CEAUSESCU SAID HE WANTED TO "ASSURE THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY AND THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE THAT THEY WILL ALWAYS FIND OUR PARTY AND PEOPLE THEIR TRUSTED FRIENDS."
