X/4 C/S - RADIO PRAGUE OFF AIR AGAIN BUT OTHER STATIONS CONTINUE

MUNICH, AUG.21 (CMD)- RADIO PRAGUE IS OFF THE AIR,
BUT SOME OTHER RADIO STATIONS AND TELEVISION TRANSMITTERS
IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA ARE CONTINUING TO BROADCAST, AS OF 1145 MT.

SOME OF THE OTHER STATIONS, SUCH AS RADIO PLZEN, WENT OFF THE
AIR -- JUST AS RADIO PRAGUE DID -- BUT THEN CAME BACK AGAIN.

THE FREQUENCIES OF RADIO PRAGUE ARE BEING USED BY SUCH
STATIONS AS OSTRAVA AND BUDEJOVICE, IN BROADCASTS TO THEIR LOCAL
AUDIENCES.

CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION IS BROADCASTING ON ITS OWN FREQUENCY.

AT 1000 MT, BRATISLAVA TELEVISION ANNOUNCED IT IS BROADCASTING
FROM THE BRNO TELEVISION STUDIO.

BRNO TELEVISION EARLIER TODAY USED THE RADIO PRAGUE
FREQUENCY TO BROADCAST ITS REPORTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE
MOVEMENT OF WARSAW PACT TROOPS INTO CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

BRNO SAID AT 0930 MT THAT ACCORDING TO THE LATEST INFORMATION,
"THE FOREIGN COMMANDER OF BRNO HAS BEEN LOOKING FOR THE HEAD-
QUARTERS OF BRNO TELEVISION."

"IN THE MEANTIME," THE BRNO ANNOUNCER CONTINUED, "BRNO CITIZENS
ARE SENDING SOVIET PATROLS ALWAYS IN THE OPPOSITE DIRECTION
FROM US."

RADIO PRAGUE HAS BEEN OFF THE AIR SINCE ABOUT 0800 MT.
