X/4 C/S - 1ST ADD - RADIO PLZEN SAYS... (CN 128)

XXX COMMUNICATIONS

A FEW MINUTES EARLIER RADIO PLZEN SAID (1125 HOURS M.T.) THAT THE BRATISLAVA BUILDING OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE HAS BEEN OCCUPIED BY FOREIGN TROOPS.

THE RADIO SAID THE BUILDING IS "OCCUPIED IN SUCH A WAY, HOWEVER, THAT PEOPLE CAN COME AND LEAVE."

ACCORDING TO THE RADIO, THE OCCUPATION OF THE BRATISLAVA CAPITAL "TOOK PLACE, ACCORDING TO A REPORT FROM BRATISLAVA, WITHOUT SERIOUS INCIDENTS."

RADIO PLZEN SAID FURTHER "PEOPLE ARE CHANTING IN THE STREETS (OF BRATISLAVA) GLORY TO (PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER) DUBCEK AND (CZECHOSLOVAK PRESIDENT LUDVIK) SVOBODA."

THE RADIO SAID IN THE SAME BROADCAST THE BRATISLAVA RADIO AND TELEVISION BUILDING "HAS BEEN OCCUPIED BY OCCUPATION TROOPS."

THE RADIO SAID "GUARDING TROOPS DO NOT RPT NOT ALLOW ANYBODY TO ENTER OR LEAVE THE BUILDING" OF THE BRATISLAVA RADIO.

AT 1128, RADIO PLZEN SAID: "WE HAVE JUST RECEIVED A REPORT THAT OCCUPATION ARMIES ARE APPROACHING THE TOWN OF TABOR (SOUTHERN BOHEMIA)."
