

X/4 C/S - CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT MEETS

MUNICH, AUG.21 - (CMD)- THE CZECHOSLOVAK NEWS AGENCY CETEKA REPORTS THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN IN SESSION SINCE THIS MORNING.

THE CETEKA REPORT READS:

"THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN IN SESSION SINCE THIS MORNING ACCORDING TO UNOFFICIAL REPORTS REACHING CETEKA".

"NO RPT NO DETAILS ARE AVAILABLE".

RADIO BANSKA BYSTRICA THIS MORNING CALLED UPON ALL WORKERS OF THE FILLING STATIONS TO GIVE PRIORITY SERVICE TO THE MEMBERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY'S CENTRAL COMMITTEE AS WELL AS THE DEPUTIES OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY "WHO ARE ON THEIR WAY FOR A SESSION IN PRAGUE".

CETEKA LATER REPORTED THE PRESIDUM OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY HAS SENT A DELEGATION TO SOVIET AMBASSADOR TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA STEPAN CHERVONENKO AT 1000 MT. TODAY.

ACCORDING THE NEWS AGENCY THE DELEGATION HAS THE MISSION TO "ESTABLISH CONTACTS AND ARRANGE THE POSSIBILITY OF FREE MOVEMENT FOR TALKS WITH THE GOVERNMENT AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC".

CETEKA SAID THE DELEGATION IS LED BY MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY'S PRESIDUM, ZDENEK FIERLINGER AND MEMBERS OF THE DELEGATION ARE, AMONG OTHERS, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY JOSEF ZEDNIK, AND MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY'S PRESIDUM ALOIS POLEDNAK.
