

EMBASSIES UNDER GUARD IN THE HAGUE

THE HAGUE, AUG. 21 (RFE SPECIAL/JM/RD) -- DUTCH POLICE THIS MORNING PUT HEAVY SECURITY GUARDS AROUND THE EMBASSIES OF FOUR OF THE COUNTRIES WHOSE TROOPS INVADED CZECHOSLOVAKIA LAST NIGHT.

THERE WERE NO RPT NO DEMONSTRATIONS OR ANY SIGNS OF POSSIBLE VIOLENCE AND OFFICIALS DESCRIBED THE MOVES AS MERELY PRECAUTIONARY.

THE GUARDS WERE STATIONED AROUND THE EMBASSIES OF THE SOVIET UNION, POLAND, HUNGARY, AND BULGARIA. HOLLAND DOES NOT MAINTAIN RELATIONS WITH EAST GERMANY.

MAYOR OF MOSCOW BREAKS OFF VISIT TO HOLLAND

AMSTERDAM, AUG. 21 (RFE SPECIAL/JM/RD) -- THE MAYOR OF MOSCOW, MR. PROMUSLOV, TODAY BROKE OFF A VISIT TO HOLLAND AND WAS FLYING BACK TO THE SOVIET CAPITAL THIS AFTERNOON.

HE ARRIVED LAST WEEK ON AN OFFICIAL VISIT AS THE GUEST OF AMSTERDAM MAYOR VAN HALL WHO MADE A VISIT TO MOSCOW IN JUNE 1965.

OFFICIALS SAID THIS MORNING THAT PROMUSLOV HAD CANCELLED PLANS FOR SIGHTSEEING IN AMSTERDAM AND THEN LATER REVEALED THAT HE WOULD LEAVE SCHIPHOL AIRPORT ON A REGULAR DUTCH AIRLINE FLIGHT TO MOSCOW AT 1300 MT. HE HAD PLANNED TO RETURN TO THE SOVIET UNION TOMORROW ABOARD A RUSSIAN FLIGHT. OFFICIALS WOULD NOT RPT NOT COMMENT ON HIS EARLY DEPARTURE.

DUTCH CP MEETING ON CZECHOSLOVAK SITUATION

AMSTERDAM, AUG. 21 (RFE SPECIAL/JB/JM/RD) -- THE DUTCH COMMUNIST PARTY WENT INTO SECRET CONSULTATIONS THIS MORNING TO DISCUSS THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

A PARTY SPOKESMAN SAID THE MEETING WAS A REGULARLY SCHEDULED ONE AND NOT RPT NOT AN EMERGENCY ONE.

DUTCH CABINET SESSION ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA

THE HAGUE, AUG. 21 (RFE SPECIAL/JM/RD) -- THE DUTCH CABINET MET IN SPECIAL SESSION THIS MORNING TO DISCUSS DEVELOPMENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

GOVERNMENT SPOKESMEN DECLINED TO COMMENT ON THE MEETING.

HOLLAND HAS BEEN PROMOTING CLOSER TIES WITH PRAGUE FOR THE PAST 18 MONTHS, ESPECIALLY IN THE TRADE FIELD. SEVERAL TOP DUTCH OFFICIALS, INCLUDING FOREIGN MINISTER JOSEPH LUNS AND FOREIGN TRADE MINISTER LEO DE BLOCK HAVE VISITED CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN RECENT MONTHS.
