

C/S - FATALITIES REPORTED BY CETEKA

MUNICH, AUGUST 21 (CNR)- THE CZECHOSLOVAK NEWSAGENCY CETEKA SAID TODAY THAT THERE WERE "SOME FATAL INJURIES" IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK EVENTS THIS MORNING.

THE AGENCY ALSO SAID THAT 25 PEOPLE WERE TAKEN TO HOSPITAL BY AMBULANCES FROM AROUND THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO BUILDING IN PRAGUE.

THE FULL TEXT OF THE CETEKA ITEM RECEIVED A FEW MINUTES AGO READS:

"TWENTY FIVE WOUNDED PERSONS WERE TAKEN TO HOSPITAL BY THE FIRST AID AMBULANCES FROM AROUND THE BUILDING OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO THIS MORNING.

"THERE WERE ALSO SOME FATAL INJURIES.

"THIS WAS STATED HERE TODAY BY THE HEAD NURSE OF THE PRAGUE EMERGENCY FIRST AID STATION.

"AT THE PRESENT MOMENT THE SITUATION IS MUDDLED FOR THE FIRST AID AMBULANCES IN THE AREA AROUND THE RADIO STATION. IT WAS JUST STATED BY A DOCTOR WHO HAD BEEN NEAR THE RADION THAT TWO PERSONS WERE KILLED NEAR THE RADIO." (END TEXT)

AN CETEKA ITEM CARRIED A FEW MINUTES EARLIER SAID (TEXT):

"TWELVE INJURED PERSONS, INCLUDING THREE VERY SEVERELY, WERE TAKEN TO THE FACULTY HOSPITAL IN THE CENTRE OF PRAGUE TODAY.

THEY WERE WOUNDED ON THE HEAD AND ABDOMEN. FURTHER INJURED PERSONS ARE ALREADY BEING ACCEPTED IN OTHER PRAGUE HOSPITALS.
