

X/4 C/S - U THANT REPORTEDLY TO VISIT C/S

MUNICH, AUG 21 (CMD) - RADIO PRAGUE SAID AT 1233 HOURS M.T.
"THE SPOKESMAN OF THE GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE UNITED NATIONS SAID
TUESDAY NIGHT THAT GENERAL SECRETARY U THANT STILL INTENDS TO
LEAVE BY PLANE ON THURSDAY FOR HIS PLANNED VISIT TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

THE RADIO ALSO REPORTED AT 1236 HOURS M.T. A STATEMENT OF THE
CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY IN LONDON WHICH SAID:

"WE WILL REMAIN THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK
SOCIALIST REPUBLIC AND OF THE LEGAL GOVERNMENT OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

THE RADIO SAID THIS WAS STATED BY THE SPOKESMAN OF THE
CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY IN LONDON, THIS MORNING.

THE RADIO THEN QUOTED A STATEMENT OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF
THE ANTIFASCIST FIGHTERS, ADDRESSED TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT,
AS SAYING:

"WE DEMAND OUR GOVERNMENT THAT IT SHOULD ADDRESS, WITHOUT
DELAY THE UNITED NATIONS WITH THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT:

1. IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA THERE TOOK PLACE TODAY AN UNPROVOKED
AGGRESSION.

2. DEMAND AN IMMEDIATE CONVOCATION OF THE UNITED NATIONS
SECURITY COUNCIL.

3. TO TAKE NECESSARY MEASURES, THROUGH THE UNITED NATIONS
SECURITY COUNCIL, LEADING TO AN IMMEDIATE DEPARTURE OF THE
OCCUPANTS FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND TO THE RESTORATION OF OUR
SOVEREIGNTY."

"WE DEMAND A MESSAGE WHETHER THE GOVERNMENT IS ABLE TO FULFILL
OUR DEMANDS."

SIGNED THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE ANTIFASCIST FIGHTERS."
