X/13 C/S - WEST GERMANS DEMONSTRATE AT SOVIET EMBASSY

BONN, AUG 21 (DPA/GND) - A GROUP OF WEST GERMAN STUDENTS DEMONSTRATED AT THE SOVIET EMBASSY TODAY AND BRIEFLY DELAYED THE AMBASSADOR AS HE TRIED TO LEAVE THE BUILDING.

THE STUDENTS WERE PROTESTING THE WARSAW PACT OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA. STUDENT GROUPS THROUGHOUT WEST GERMANY PLANNED DEMONSTRATIONS FOR TODAY.

THE STUDENTS, ABOUT 150 OF THEM, DEMONSTRATED AT THE SOVIET EMBASSY IN ROLANDSECK, NEAR BONN. THEY PREVENTED AMBASSADOR SEMYON TSARAPKIN FROM LEAVING THE BUILDING FOR ABOUT TEN MINUTES BY THROWING THEMSELVES IN FRONT OF THE AMBASSADOR'S CAR.

RHEINELAND-PALATINATE POLICE DRAGGED AND CARRIED THE STUDENTS AWAY.

A SPOKESMAN OF THE LIBERAL STUDENT FEDERATION SAID HIS ORGANIZATION WOULD CARRY A CZECHOSLOVAK FLAG, A VIETCONG FLAG AND A RED FLAG TO INDICATE THE SYMPATHIES OF THE DEMONSTRATORS.

THE POLICE ALSO INCREASED THEIR GUARDS AT THE RUMANIAN EMBASSY NEAR COLOGNE AND AT THE POLISH AND SOVIET TRADE MISSIONS IN COLOGNE.

THE JUNE 17, 1953, UNION CALLED ON THE POPULATION OF MUNICH TO TAKE PART IN A PROTEST MARCH THIS AFTERNOON.
