X/4 C/S - 1ST ADD - C/S GOVERNMENT MEETS (CN 144) XXX POLEDNAK

RADIO PRAGUE SAID AT 1220 MT: "WE REPEAT OUR MORNING REPORT THAT COMRADE CESTMIR CISAR (CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE SECRETARY) WAS THIS MORNING TAKEN OUT OF HIS FLAT AND TRANSPORTED AWAY BY TWO CIVILIANS.

"AS SOON AS WE RECEIVE FURTHER DETAILS WE WILL, OF COURSE, INFORM YOU IMMEDIATELY."

RADIO PILZEN SAID AT 1140 MT SAID THAT ACCORDING TO UNOFFICIAL REPORTS FROM CETEKA, THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN HOLDING SESSION SINCE THIS MORNING. IT ADDED THAT THE OFFICES OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PAPER, RUDE PRAVO WAS OCCUPIED BY THE OCCUPYING TROOPS.

THE RADIO ALSO SAID THAT THE PRESIDUM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONAL ASSEMBLY WAS DISCUSSING SINCE THIS MORNING THE SITUATION WHICH HAS ARISEN BY THE OCCUPATION OF THE REPUBLIC BY THE ARMIES OF THE SOVIET UNION, EAST GERMANY, POLAND, HUNGARY AND BULGARIA. THE RADIO SAID THAT THE PRESIDUM IS MAKING EFFORTS TO ESTABLISH CONTACTS FOR TALKS WITH THE USSR AMBASSADOR IN PRAGUE AND WITH THE COMMANDER OF THE OCCUPYING ARMIES.

IN A LATER BROADCAST, RADIO PILZEN SAID THAT A SIX-MAN DELEGATION OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONAL ASSEMBLY PRESIDUM IS HOLDING TALKS WITH THE SOVIET AMBASSADOR TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA.
