CS - 3RD ADD GERMANS DEMONSTRATE (CN 192) XXX CZECHOSLOVAKIA

(UPI)- IN BONN DEMONSTRATORS PROTESTING THE INVASION SPLATTERED THE SOVIET EMBASSY WITH EGGS AND HINDRED THE DEPARTURE OF AMBASSADOR SEMYON TSARAPKIN FOR HIS MEETING WITH CHANCELLOR KIESINGER.

THE DEMONSTRATION BEGAN WHEN A GROUP OF ABOUT 50 YOUNG STUDENTS GATHERED IN FRONT OF THE EMBASSY IN SUBURBAN ROLANDSECK BUT SWELLED TO A CROWD OF 400 BY NOON.

PASSING MOTORISTS BLEW THEIR HORNS IN A BLARING PROTEST OF THE INVASION.

POLICE CLEARED A PATH FOR TSARAPKIN'S CAR.

THE CROWD SHOUTED "MURDERER. MURDERER." AND SUCH SLOGANS AS "MUNICH 1938--MOSCOW 1968," "STALIN LIVES." "MURDERERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE" AND "UP DUBCEK."

STUDENTS HAVE CALLED OTHER DEMONSTRATIONS FOR TONIGHT.
