UNITED NATIONS, AUG 21, REUTER -- LORD CARADON,

THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ASKED MR. MUZIK, THE RANKING OFFICIAL IN  
THE PRAGUE DELEGATION, TO CALL ON HIM.
