

X/4 C/S -- 1ST ADD CS NATIONAL ASSEMBLY (CN 246) XXX UNANIMOUSLY

THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY STATEMENT SAID FURTHER "WE CALL UPON ALL THE PEOPLE NOT RPT NOT TO RESORT TO VIOLENT ACTIONS AGAINST THE OCCUPATION TROOPS NOT TO ALLOW THEMSELVES TO GET PROVOKED BY VARIOUS FORCES WHICH WANT TO RECEIVE EVIDENCE FOR THE JUSTIFICATION OF THE INTERVENTION, AND (WHICH WANT) TO MAKE THE USE OF THE SITUATION FOR SO-CALLED ACTIONS."

THE STATEMEN CONTINUED BY SAYING "WORKING PEOPLE, CITIZENS, STAY AT YOUR PLACES OF WORK AND PROTECT YOUR FACTORIES. FOR THE FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF SOCIALISM IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, MAKE USE OF ALL DEMOCRATIC MEANS."

THE STATEMENT SAID "IF IT WILL BE NEEDED, YOU WILL CERTAINLY BE ABLE TO DEFEND YOURSELVES ALSO BY THE GENERAL STRIKE. A GOOD LIFE OF THIS COUNTRY CAN ONLY BE ENSURED BY THE PEOPLE WHO LIVE AND WORK IN IT. WE BELIEVE THAT WE WILL COME OUT OF THESE DIFFICULT MOMENTS WITH RAISED HEAD AND STRAIGHT BACK."

THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY FURTHER SAID IN THE STATEMENT: "WE ASSOCIATE OURSELVES WITH THE DECLARATION OF THE PRESIDUM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY AND THE PRESIDUM OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY WHICH DESCRIBES THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY FIVE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES AS A VIOLATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL LAW, OF THE DECISIONS OF THE WARSAW TREATY, AND (A VIOLATION) OF THE PRINCIPLES OF EQUAL RELATIONS BETWEEN NATIONS."
