

X/4 C/S CHILDREN VISITING CZECHOSLOVAKIA ARE SAFE

MUNICH, AUG 21 (CMD)- CETEKA TODAY ASKED THAT WESTERN NEWS AGENCIES BE INFORMED THAT THE CHILDREN FROM SIX WESTERN COUNTRIES AT THE LUETI PETERSON CAMP IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA ARE SAFE IN THE SWEDISH AND AMERICAN EMBASSIES IN PRAGUE.

ON THE OTHER HAND, THE EAST GERMAN RADIO NETWORK SAID TODAY THAT THOSE CITIZENS OF EAST GERMANY VISITING CZECHOSLOVAKIA SHOULD STAY IN THE PLACES THEY ARE VISITING UNTIL TRAVEL POSSIBILITIES BECOME AVAILABLE.

THE RADIO ALSO SAID THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAKS VISITING EAST GERMANY SHOULD REMAIN IN THE PLACES THEY ARE VISITING UNTIL TRAVEL POSSIBILITIES FOR THEM ARE AVAILABLE.

AS FOR APPROXIMATELY 50,000 CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS VISITING YUGOSLAVIA, TANJUG SAID TODAY THAT CITIZENS OF ZAGREB ARE INVITING THEM TO STAY IN THEIR HOMES FREE.

IN NIS, SERBIA, THE STRANDED CZECHOSLOVAKS ARE BEING REFERRED TO A SPECIAL SERVICE FOR THE ASSISTANCE TO CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS IN THE WAY OF INFORMATION AND MATERIAL AID, TANJUG REPORTED.

IN SARAJEVO, YUGOSLAVIA, GROUPS OF CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS WENT TO THE OFFICE OF THE YUGOSLAV NEWS AGENCY AND REQUESTED THEM TO HELP OBTAIN INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY IN SARAJEVO AS TO WHAT THEIR DUTIES SHOULD BE.

IN ADDITION, THE "INVASION" OF WARSAW PACT TROOPS INTO CZECHOSLOVAKIA CAUSED WHAT CETEKA TERMED THE GREATEST SCIENTIFIC MEETING IN THE COUNTRY'S HISTORY TO BE ABRUPTLY HALTED.

CETEKA SAID THE 3,200 DELEGATES TO THE INTERNATIONAL GEOLOGICAL CONGRESS BEING HELD IN PRAGUE ARE PRESENTLY IN PRAGUE'S TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY BUILDING WITH EIGHT TANKS PATROLLING NEARBY. THE TANKS WERE NOT RPT NOT IDENTIFIED.
