

X/4 C/S - YUGOSLAV REACTION TO CZECHOSLOVAK DEVELOPMENTS

MUNICH, 21. AUG, (CMD)- REPORTS ABOUT THE ENTRY OF WARSAW PACT TROOPS INTO CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAVE CAUSED "CONCERN AND AGITATION IN ALL PARTS OF YUGOSLAVIA," TANJUG REPORTS.

AT A MEETING WEDNESDAY MORNING, THE PRESIDENCY OF THE SLOVENIAN TRADE UNIONS EXPRESSED A "RESOLUTE PROTEST" AGAINST THE ENTRY OF WARSAW PACT TROOPS INTO CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND WARNED ABOUT THE SERIOUS EFFECTS OF THIS MOVE ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF SOCIALISM IN THE WORLD, THE TANJUG DISPATCH CONTINUED.

WORKERS COLLECTIVES AND SOCIO-POLITICAL ORGANIZATIONS IN THE REPUBLIC OF SLOVENIA ARE HOLDING MEETINGS TO EXPRESS THEIR SUPPORT TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE AND ITS LEADERSHIP.

THE SLOVENIAN TRADE UNIONS HAVE CALLED ON THE CITIZENS TO GIVE ALL NECESSARY HELP TO CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS WHO ARE NOW IN YUGOSLAVIA.

PRESIDENT TITO HAS CALLED AN URGENT MEETING OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS OF YUGOSLAVIA FOR 2000 MT HOURS WEDNESDAY NIGHT. THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE MEETING DID NOT RPT NOT SPECIFY THE AGENDA BUT IT IS CERTAIN TO BE ABOUT CZECHOSLOVAKIA, TANJUG SAYS.

THE BELGRADE NEWSPAPER VECERNJE NOVOSTI PUT OUT THE FIRST EXTRA EDITION WEDNESDAY MORNING WITH NEWS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA. SHORTLY AFTERWARD BORBA AND POLITIKA ALSO PUT OUT EXTRA EDITIONS.

THE FOOTBALL TEAM RED STAR OF BELGRADE WAS IN TRNAVA, CZECHOSLOVAKIA WHERE THEY WERE TO PLAY THE FIRST MATCH OF THE CENTRAL EUROPEAN CUP FINAL WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON. OFFICIALS OF THE TEAM IN BELGRADE WERE TRYING TO CONTACT THEM AND ARRANGE FOR THEIR RETURN TO YUGOSLAVIA, ALTHOUGH THERE IS NO RPT NO AIR OR OTHER TRANSPORT OUT OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, TANJUG REPORTED.
