

X/4 C/S - C/S RADIO AMATEURS ASKED TO BROADCAST TO USSR, POLAND,
HUNGARY

MUNICH, AUGUST 21 (CMD)- RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA ONE
ASKED ALL RADIO AMATEURS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA TO BROADCAST REPORTS
TO THE SOVIET UNION, POLAND AND HUNGARY ON THE REAL SITUATION
IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, WHICH IT DESCRIBED AS "THE OCCUPATION OF OUR
STATE AND THE VIOLATION OF OUR CZECHOSLOVAK SOUVEREIGNTY."

IT ALSO ASKED THEM TO REPORT THAT "WHAT IS TAKING PLACE IS
HAPPENING AGAINST THE WILL OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE."

THE RADIO ASKED THE RADIO AMATEURS TO BROADCAST REPORTS
IN RUSSIAN, POLISH AND GERMAN LANGUAGES, AND EXPLAIN TO THE
OCCUPATION TROOPS WHAT IS THE SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY,
THAT THE DID NOT RPT NOT COME THE WARSAW DID NOT RPT NOT COME PACT
TROOPS) TO PREVENT THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK
SOCIALIST REPUBLIC, BUT THAT THEY HAVE OCCUPIED A FREE COUNTRY.

THE BROADCAST SAID THE SUGGESTION FOR AMATEUR BROADCASTING
CAME FROM THE RADIO AMATEURS FROM GOTTWALDOV (MORAVIA).
