CS- STEWART: MAJOR POWERS WILL SEEK CONDEMNATION OF INVASION

LONDON, AUG 21, (UPI)-- THE LEADING FREE WORLD POWERS WILL SEEK A CLEAR CONDEMNATION OF THE SOVIET INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN THE U.N. SECURITY COUNCIL, BRITISH FOREIGN SECRETARY MICHAEL STEWART SAID TODAY.

STEWART SAID THE SECURITY COUNCIL MAY MEET TONIGHT TO DISCUSS THE CRISIS.

THE BRITISH FOREIGN SECRETARY MADE HIS ANNOUNCEMENT AT A LONDON PRESS CONFERENCE AFTER A FULL DAY OF CONCENTRATED DISCUSSIONS WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF OTHER NORTH ATLANTIC TREATY ORGANIZATION AND COMMONWEALTH POWERS ON THE CRISIS.

"THE WEST IS SEEKING TO OBTAIN A CLEAR DECLARATION OF WORLD OPINION CONDEMNING THE SOVIET INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN THE SECURITY COUNCIL," STEWART SAID.
