X/4 C/S - STEPS TO CONVENE PARTY CONGRESS (RELEADS CN 210)

MUNICH, AUG 21 (CMD)- RADIO PRAGUE SAID TODAY THAT THE PRAGUE CITY COMMUNIST PARTY COMMITTEE HAS CALLED "ALL THE DELEGATES OF THE 14TH (EXTRAORDINARY) CONGRESS" OF THE PARTY SCHEDULED TO BE HELD ON SEPT. 9 "TO COME TO PRAGUE IMMEDIATELY."

IN THE MEANTIME, RADIO BRNO REPORTED TODAY THAT THE WORKERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE ASKED ALL MEMBERS OF THE PARTY'S CENTRAL COMMITTEE TO ESTABLISH CONTACT IMMEDIATELY WITH THE MEMBERS OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE WHO CAN BE REACHED.

RADIO PRAGUE SAID THE DELEGATES EXPECTING TO ATTEND THE SEPT 9 CONGRESS SHOULD "REPORT TO THE DISTRICT PARTY COMMITTEES, OR AT BIG ENTERPRISES' COMMITTEES, AND BE ABLE TO START CONGRESS PROCEEDINGS."

MEANWHILE CETEKA REPORTED THAT THE PLENUM OF THE CENTRAL BOHEMIAN REGIONAL COMMITTEE TODAY SUCCEEDED IN ESTABLISHING CONTACTS WITH MOST OF THE DISTRICTS IN THE REGION.

NOW MEETING AROUND THE CLOCK, THE PLENUM SESSION EXPRESSED "PRINCIPAL DISAGREEMENT" WITH THE PRESENCE OF WARSAW PACT TROOPS ON CZECHOSLOVAK TERRITORY, CETEKA SAID.

DURING AN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE NORTH BOHEMIAN DISTRICT NATIONAL COMMITTEE HELD IN USTI NAD LABEM, A PROCLAMATION WAS ISSUED BY THE SESSION WHICH DEMANDED THAT THE WARSAW PACT TROOPS NOW OCCUPYING CZECHOSLOVAKIA SHOULD LEAVE, CETEKA SAID.
