STOCKHOLM TABLOIDS, THE SOCIAL-DEMOCRATIC "AFTONBLADET" AND THE LIBERAL "EXPRESSEN", ISSUED EXTRA EDITIONS AROUND NOON AND FOLLOWED WITH THEIR REGULAR EDITIONS IN MIDAFTERNOON FULL OF CZECHOSLOVAK COVERAGE.

"AFTONBLADET" CARRIED FIVE PAGES OF CZECHOSLOVAK NEWS IN ITS EARLY EDITION AND 13 PAGES IN ITS REGULAR 40-PAGE PAPER.

IN VIENNA, NEWSPAPERS PUT OUT THREE AND FOUR EXTRA EDITIONS WEDNESDAY TO REPORT ON THE CZECHOSLOVAK CRISES.
