C/S -1ST ADD BONN DEMONSTRATORS (CN 335) XXX TONIGHT

EARLIER TUESDAY NIGHT, SEVERAL PERSONS HAD PEACEFULLY PICKETED OUTSIDE THE CONSULATE PROTESTING THE INVASION. ALTHOUGH PICTURES OF THE PICKETS APPEARED IN LOCAL NEWSPAPERS TODAY, KIWACZ SAID, "THERE WERE NO PICKETS."

IN SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA, ABOUT 120 STUDENTS MARCHED FROM DOWNTOWN TO POINT PIPER WHERE THEY DEMONSTRATED IN FRONT OF THE POLISH CONSULATE. THERE WERE NO ARRESTS.

IN TOKYO, FIFTEEN HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS DEMONSTRATED IN FRONT OF THE SOVIET EMBASSY. THEY WERE QUICKLY DISPERSED BY RIOT POLICE.

IN STOCKHOLM, 50 PERSONS PROTESTED OUTSIDE THE SOVIET TOURIST AGENCY INTOURIST AND SOME PAINTED SLOGANS ON THE WINDOWS. ONE 18-YEAR-OLD YOUTH WAS ARRESTED.

"THIS IS PAINT BUT IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA IT'S BLOOD," READ ONE OF THE SLOGANS.

DEMONSTRATIONS WERE SCHEDULED FOR TONIGHT ALL OVER SWEDEN BY THE RULING SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY.
