

X/13 BERLIN-- STUDENTS DEMONSTRATE AT CZECHOSLOVAK MISSION

BERLIN, AUG. 21 (RFE SPECIAL/WULFF)- ABOUT 3,000 WEST BERLIN STUDENTS AND MEMBERS OF POLITICAL ORGANIZATIONS ARE PRESENTLY CONDUCTING A PROTEST DEMONSTRATION AT THE CZECHOSLOVAK MILITARY MISSION IN WEST BERLIN.

WEST BERLIN POLICE SAID THE MARCHERS EXPRESSED THEIR WISH TO CONDUCT A SYMPATHY DEMONSTRATION AT THE MISSION. THEY ARE CARRYING POSTERS SAYING "WHO HAS BETRAYED THE REVOLUTION -- THE RED BUREAUCRATS," AND "DOWN WITH STALINISM -- SOCIALISM WILL WIN."

POLICE SAID MANY OF THE DEMONSTRATORS CARRIED RED FLAGS AND SHOUTED "VIVAT DUBCEK."

THE DEMONSTRATORS READ OUT A RESOLUTION AT THE MISSION.

BEFORE THE DEMONSTRATORS HAD LEFT THEIR GATHERING POINT AT OLIVAER PLATZ, THEY MARCHED TO THE SOVIET TRAVEL AGENCY "INTOURIST" LOCATED THERE AND SHOUTED "BREAK BRESHNEVS BONES -- ALL POWER TO THE COUNCILS (BRECHT BRESCHNEW DIE GRAETEN -- ALLE MACHT DEN RAETEN), AND SANG THE INTERNATIONAL.

PARTICIPANTS OF ANOTHER DEMONSTRATION ALSO TAKING PLACE AT OLIVAER PLATZ, HAD CARRIED POSTERS TO THE INTOURIST OFFICE SAYING "WE GREET DUBCEK AND THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA," AND "WE WARN OUR COLD WARRIORS: DO NOT INTERFERE."

BEFORE THE DEMONSTRATION BEGAN, A "TEACH IN" WAS CONDUCTED AT WEST BERLINS TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY WHERE A SPEAKER ANNOUNCED THAT THE WEST BERLIN COMMUNIST PARTY SED HAD REFUSED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DEMONSTRATION SAYING THAT THE EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WERE "NO REASON FOR COOPERATION IN CERTAIN POINTS."

THE SPOKESMAN TOLD THE AUDIENCE THAT THOSE WHO WERE NOT READY TO COOPERATE NOW COULD NOT EXPECT ANY COOPERATION FROM THE STUDENTS EITHER.
