TSARAPKING BOOED

BONN, AUG. 21, REUTER - SOVIET AMBASSADOR SEMYON TSAR-
APKIN WAS BOOED AND HISSED BY HUNDREDS OF DEMONSTRATORS TODAY
AFTER HE CALLED ON WEST GERMANY CHANCELLOR KURT GEORG KIESINGER.

A CROWD OF MORE THAN 200 YOUNG PEOPLE FORCED THE AMBASSADOR
TO LEAVE BY A SIDE ENTRANCE AND THEN CHASED HIS OFFICIAL
CAR AS IT SPED THROUGH AN UNDERPASS BACK TOWARDS THE SOVIET
EMBASSY.

KENYAN MINISTER DEPLORES 'GUNBOAT DIPLOMACY'

NAIROBI, AUG 21, REUTER - KENYAS FOREIGN AFFAIRS MINISTER, MINISTER,
CHIEDO ARGWINGS- KODHEK, TODAY CRITICISED THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA
AND SAID: "WE DONT WANT GUNBOAT DIPLOMACY IN 1968."

HE TOLD A REPORTER THAT HIS GOVERNMENT WOULD ISSUE A FULL, FORMAL
STATEMENT ON THE SITUATION TOMORROW MORNING.

TANANARIVE, AUG. 21, REUTER--MALAGASY PRESIDENT PHILIBERT
TSIRANANA IN A STATEMENT TODAY ATTACKED THE SOVIET INVASION OF

HE CRITICISED THE SOVIET SYSTEM IN GENERAL AND POINTED
OUT: "IT IS DANGEROUS TO FLIRT WITH THE REDS. I AM MORE THAN
EVER OPPOSED TO COMMUNISM."
