X/4 C/S -- CSSR RADIOS APPEAL TO OCCUPATIONAL TROOPS

MUNICH, AUG 21 (CMD)-- TWO CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO STATIONS TODAY CARRIED APPEALS ADDRESSED TO THE SOVIET, HUNGARIAN AND EAST GERMAN SOLDIERS.

RADIO CESKE BUDEJOVICE CARRIED THE APPEALS IN GERMAN, HUNGARIAN AND IN RUSSIAN WITHOUT A TRANSLATION.

RADIO BANSKA BYSTRICA BROADCAST THE APPEAL IN RUSSIAN AND ADDED A SLOVAK TRANSLATION.

THE APPEAL PROPOSED TO THE SOVIET SOLDIERS AND OFFICERS "A HUMAN DIALOGUE" BETWEEN REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SOVIET TROOPS AND OF THE LEGAL PARTY AND STATE ORGANS OF THE DISTRICT AND LOCAL BODIES " WHICH HAVE THE FULL SUPPORT OF THE ENTIRE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE."

THE APPEAL BEGS THE SOVIET SOLDIERS AND OFFICERS "TO UNDERSTAND US; WE ARE CONCERNED WITH SOCIALISM, WITH ITS HUMAN FACE, ITS REAL DEMOCRATIC AND HUMANISTIC CONTENTS."

"WE DO NOT WANT ANY MISUNDERSTANDINGS BETWEEN YOU AND US; ON THE CONTRARY WE WANT COMRADELY TALKS ON A FRIENDLY LEVEL AS WE ARE OBLIGED TO IT BY THE CIERNA NAD TISOU AND THE TALKS BY THE SIX BROTHERLY PARTIES IN BRATISLAVA....," THE APPEAL SAID IN CONCLUSION.

RADIO CESKE BUDEJOVICE ALSO CALLED ON THE POPULATION TO PRESERVE CALM ESPECIALLY DURING THE NIGHT.

THE RADIO SAID THAT OSTRAVA RADIO ON THE 197 METERS WAVE LENGTH WAS BROADCASTING FALSE REPORTS. ONE CAN ASSUME THAT THE STATION IS IN THE HANDS OF THE OCCUPANTS, THE RADIO ADDED.
