X/4 C/S -- 1ST ADD - FURTHER C/S PROTEST NOTE... (CN 25) XXX CISAR

THE NOTE SAID FURTHER, THE RADIO REPORTED: "THE CZECHOSLOVAK STATE OR OTHER ORGANS HAVE NO RPT NO FURTHER INFORMATION ABOUT THE FATE OF DR. CISAR."

"THE DELEGATION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, WHICH WAS SENT TO THE EMBASSY OF THE SOVIET UNION, IN PRAGUE, HAS NOT RPT NOT RETURNED."

"THE IMMEDIATE RELEASE OF DR. CISAR AND THE DELEGATION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY IS A DEMAND WHICH CORRESPONDS TO THE ELEMENTARY CONCEPTION OF LAW, AND CZECHOSLOVAK QUARTERSEXPECT THAT SIMILAR CASES WILL CERTAINLY NOT RPT NOT BE REPEATED ANY MORE."

"THE NOTE SAYS FURTHER," THE RADIO CONTINUED, "THAT AT VARIOUS PLACES THERE HAS BEEN BLOODSHED IN THE RANKS OF CIVILIANS, AND ALSO DAMAGE TO PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND HOUSING SITES, AND UNFORESEEABLE LOSSES TO THE ENTIRE NATIONAL ECONOMY."

"PROVISIONING THE POPULATION AND THE SUPPLY OF MEDICAL CARE TO THE INJURED IS BEING JEOPARDIZED, TRAFFIC AND COMMUNICATIONS ARE PARALYZED, MANY PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND PUBLIC FACILITIES HAVE BEEN OCCUPIED BY OCCUPATIONAL TROOPS."

THE RADIO WENT ON TO SAY THAT "THE NOTE CALLS ON THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE MENTIONED COUNTRIES, TO TAKE SUCH MEASURES AS WILL MAKE THE RESTORATION OF NORMAL LIFE IN THE COUNTRY POSSIBLE, AND TO STOP IMMEDIATELY ALL VIOLENT ACTIONS AGAINST THE POPULATIONS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA."
