X/4 C/S -- PRAGUE COMMENTATOR WANTS MOSCOW BROADCASTS IGNORED

MUNICH, AUG 22 (CMD) -- RADIO PRAGUE COMMENTATOR KAREL JEZDINSKY CALLED ON HIS FELLOW COUNTRYMEN TODAY TO IGNORE BROADCASTS COMING FROM THE SOVIET UNION.

HE MADE THE STATEMENT OVER RADIO HRADEC KRALOVE, WITH WHICH HE HAD ONLY ESTABLISHED CONTACT A SHORT TIME BEFORE.

THE RADIO QUOTED JEZDINSKY AS SAYING THAT MOSCOW RADIO WAS CARRYING "A STATEMENT OF UNNAMED REPRESENTATIVES OF OUR GOVERNMENT."

IT QUOTED HIM AS SAYING: "WE ALL KNOW WELL THAT ONLY DUBCEK STANDS AT THE HEAD OF OUR NATION. WE ARE BEHIND DUBCEK, SVOBODA, SMRKOVSKY AND CERNIK."

SOMETIME LATER, THE RADIO SAID A RESOLUTION OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE GLASS WORKS IN THE KUTNAHORA DISTRICT, EAST OF PRAGUE, CALLED ON THE INVADING COUNTRIES TO "TELL THE NAMES OF THE PERSONS AT WHOSE REQUEST THE WARSAW PACT TROOPS CROSSED OUR BORDERS."

THE RADIO SAID SEVERAL OTHER FACTORIES JOINED THIS RESOLUTION.

IN ANOTHER REPORT THE RADIO SAID "NOT RPT NOT EVEN THE (TOWN OF) NACHOD (NORTH-EAST BOHEMIA) IS SLEEPING. THE CITIZENS ARE ON THE ALERT, AND PROMISE THAT NO RPT NO SINGLE UNIT OF THE OCCUPATION ARMIES WILL PASS THROUGH THE BORDER CROSSING POINT AT BELOVES (NEAR NACHOD, CZECHOSLOVAK-POLISH BORDER.)"

THE RADIO WENT ON TO SAY "YESTERDAY, WE WERE SHOOTING ALL DAY DOCUMENTARY FILM MATERIAL. PEOPLE ARE ASSISTING US. WE ASSURE YOU THAT WE WILL CONTINUE TO SHOOT FILM MATERIAL, WHICH CAN BE, AND CERTAINLY WILL BE A PRECIOUS DOCUMENT."
