ACCORDING TO THE BROADCAST, THE SOVIET OFFICERS DID NOT RPT NOT LEAVE THE ROOM AS THE GROUP THAT ARRIVED WITH THEM ATTEMPTED TO PERSUADE THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE.

"AFTER THE TALKS, LASTING LONG HOURS, WE RECEIVED A REPORT THAT THIS GATHERING HAS DECIDED TO ISSUE A RESOLUTION," THE RADIO SAID.

THE BROADCAST ADDED THAT ALTHOUGH THE RESOLUTION STANDS FOR THE ACTION PROGRAM OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY, "IT DOES NOT RPT NOT SPEAK ABOUT...THE RELEASE OF COMRADE DUBCEK AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE, BUT ONLY ABOUT THE CONVENING OF A PLENARY MEETING OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY."

ACCORDING TO THE BROADCAST, THE RESOLUTION WAS NOT RPT NOT SIGNED WITH ANY NAMES.

THE RESOLUTION WAS QUOTED AS SAYING THAT MEMBERS OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE HAVE STARTED TALKS WITH THE "OCCUPIERS" CONCERNING THE "NORMALIZATION OF THE SITUATION."

THE RESOLUTION ALSO PROCLAIMED THE GROUP THAT PARTICIPATED IN THE MEETING AS THE HIGHEST PARTY ORGAN.

THE BROADCAST COMMENTED THAT THE PURPOSE OF THE RESOLUTION IS TO PREVENT THE EXTRAORDINARY PARTY CONGRESS WHICH IT SAID IS TO CONVENE TODAY IN PRAGUE.
