

C/S - RUDE PRAVO DISTRIBUTED

MUNICH, AUG 22 (CNR/AGENCIES) - THE OFFICIAL PARTY NEWSPAPER RUDE PRAVO CAME OUT WEDNESDAY NIGHT IN A CRUDE, MIMEOGRAPHED EDITION TO ANNOUNCE THAT THE REFORM REGIME OF ALEXANDER DUBCEK INTENDED TO CARRY ON EVEN IF THE LEADERSHIP WAS IMPRISONED.

RUDE PRAVO REPORTED THAT SOVIET TROOPS BURST INTO THE PRAGUE CENTRAL COMMITTEE HEADQUARTERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY EARLY WEDNESDAY AND HAULED OFF DUBCEK, ASSEMBLY PRESIDENT JOSEF SMRKOVSKY AND OTHER TOP OFFICIALS. THEY WERE HUSTLED INTO RED ARMY ARMORED CARS AND DRIVEN OFF TO UNKNOWN DETENTION CENTERS, IT SAID.

RUDE PRAVO, DISTRIBUTED BY YOUTHS ON BATTERED AND TANK-RINGED WENCESLAUS SQUARE AND MAIN THOROUGHFARES, URGED CZECHOSLOVAKS NOT TO COLLABORATE WITH "OCCUPYING TROOPS" AND TO BEWARE OF SOME FORM OF ALTERNATIVE GOVERNMENT MOSCOW MIGHT TRY TO SET UP.

"FOR THIS THEY WILL NEED WILLING COLLABORATORS," THE SHEET SAID.

"WE MUST NOT LET OURSELVES BE COLLABORATORS. WE SHALL SHOW THAT WE ARE UNITED AND TROOP BEHIND OUR ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES."

THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, IT SAID, PLANNED TO MEET AT 1430 TO WORK OUT IMPLEMENTATION OF RESOLUTIONS SUPPORTING DUBCEK AND DEMANDING THAT THE RUSSIANS AND THEIR WARSAW PACT ALLIES END THE ILLEGAL INVASION AND GET OUT OF THE COUNTRY.

THE MIMEOGRAPHED SHEET URGED MP'S TO BRING SANDWICHES OR A DAY'S SUPPLY OF FOOD TO LAST THEM THROUGH THE EXTRAORDINARY SESSION.
