

C/S - PRAVDA ACCUSES DUBCEK

MOSCOW, AUG. 22 (AGENCIES) -- THE KREMLIN TODAY ACCUSED CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK OF HEADING A MINORITY RIGHT-WING REVISIONIST GROUP IN THE PARTYS 11-MAN PRESIDUM.

IT SAID THE GROUP WAS GUILTY OF "PERFIDIOUS, TREACHEROUS ACTIVITIES."

IT MADE THE CHARGE AT THE END OF A MASSIVE 13,000-WORD DOCUMENT PUBLISHED IN THE COMMUNIST PARTY NEWSPAPER PRAVDA EXPLAINING YESTERDAYS OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY SOVIET AND ALLIED TROOPS.

THE DOCUMENT CHARGED MR. DUBCEK AND HIS ASSOCIATES WITH BREAKING AGREEMENTS MADE WITH SOVIET AND OTHER EAST EUROPEAN LEADERS AT TOP-LEVEL MEETINGS IN CZECHOSLOVAKI AT THE END OF JULY AND THE BEGINNING OF AUGUST.

PRAVDA SAID "EVEN AMONG THE TOP PARTY LEADERS THESE WERE PERSONS WHO OPENLY CAME OUT AGAINST THE LENINIST PRINCIPLE OF PARTY SYSTEM."

PRAVDA SAID CZECH LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK FAILED TO TAKE ANY REAL MEASURES AGAINST COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY ACTIVITIES DESPITE HIS PRONOUNCEMENTS "THAT THE MOST DECISIVE MEASURES WOULD BE TAKEN."

"SOME PARTY LEADERS PARTICIPATED IN THE OFFENSIVE AGAINST MARXISM-LENINISM WHICH WAS TAKING PLACE ALL OVER CZECHO-SLOVAKIA-PRAVDA SAID.
