C/S - 1ST ADD - PRAVDA ACCUSES DUBCEK (CN 110) XXX SAID

(UPI) - PRAVDA SAID A RECENT SOVIET-CZECH SUMMIT SESSION AT CIERNA NAD TISOU DISCLOSED A SPLIT IN THE RANKS OF THE CZECH PRESIDIUM.

IT SAID DUBCEK TOOK A "RIGHTISTS' OPPORTUNISTIC" POSITION AT THE MEETING.

"WHILE A MINORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PRESIDIUM HEADED BY DUBCEK CAME UP WITH FRANKLY RIGHTIST OPPORTUNISTIC POSITIONS, A MAJORITY TOOK A LINE OF PRINCIPLES AND STOOD UP FOR THE NECESSITY OF A DECISIVE STRUGGLE AGAINST REACTIONARY SOCIALIST FORCES AGAINST AIDING REACTION," PRAVDA SAID.

(REUTER) - "A MINORITY OF PRESIDIUM MEMBERS HEADED BY A DUBCEK CAME OUT WITH FRANKLY RIGHT-WING OPPORTUNISTIC POSITIONS." BUT THE MAJORITY TOOK A DIFFERENT LINE AND "SPOKE OF THE NECESSITY OF DECISIVE STRUGGLE AGAINST REACTIONARY ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES..." THE DOCUMENT SAID.

"HOWEVER, THE RIGHT-WING REVISIONIST ELEMENTS IN THE LEADERSHIP OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY AND GOVERNMENT OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BROKE THE AGREEMENT REACHED AT CIERNA NAD TISOU AND BRATISLAVA ABOUT DEFENDING THE POSITIONS OF SOCIALISM IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, ABOUT STRUGGLING AGAINST ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES, ABOUT REBUFFING THE SALLIES OF IMPERIALISM.

"USING DECLARATIONS ABOUT THEIR DETERMINATION TO DEFEND SOCIALISM AS A COVER, THESE PEOPLE IN FACT TRIED ONLY TO WIN TIME, CONNIVING AT COUNTER-REVOLUTION."
