STUDENTS ARRESTED AT SOVIET EMBASSY

TOKYO, AUG. 22, REUTER -- THREE STUDENTS PROTESTING AGAINST THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY WARSAW PACT TROOPS WERE ARRESTED TODAY AFTER CLIMBING A FENCE INTO THE COMPOUND OF THE SOVIET EMBASSY HERE.

POLICE SAID THEY WERE AMONG ABOUT 150 ULTRA-LEFTIST ZENGAKUREN STUDENTS WHO STAGED A PROTEST DEMONSTRATION IN FRONT OF THE EMBASSY GATE BEFORE BEING DISPERSED BY RIOT POLICE.

PARLIAMENTARIANS SCUFFLE OUTSIDE SOVIET EMBASSY

NEW DELHI, AUG 22, REUTER - INDIAN MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT WERE TAKEN AWAY BY POLICE AFTER SCUFFLES OUTSIDE THE SOVIET EMBASSY HERE TODAY.

INCIDENTS FLARED AS THE M.P.S. TRIED

TO HAND IN A PROTEST NOTE CONDEMNING THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND DEMANDING WITHDRAWAL OF THE "AGGRESSIVE ARMED FORCES."

ABOUT 70 M.P.S - MOSTLY FROM SOCIALIST AND RIGHT-WING OPPOSITION PARTIES BUT INCLUDING ONE OR TWO RULING CONGRESS MEMBERS - MARCHED IN SILENCE INFRONT OF THE EMBASSY, CORDONED OFF BY POLICE.

MOST OF THEM DISPERSED, BUT AN EMBASSY OFFICIAL REFUSED TO ALLOW A GROUP OF 17 SOCIALIST M.P.S TO ENTER THE EMBASSY GATES.

THEIR LEADERS REFUSED TO HAND THEIR PROTEST THROUGH THE GATES. IT WAS EVENTUALLY HANDED OVER BY A POLIEMAN.
