X/4 C/S - CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO CALLS FOR JAMMING OF SOVIET RADIO

MUNICH, AUG 22 (CMD) - CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S RADIO STATION AT HRADEK KRALOVE TODAY APPEALED TO SIGNAL UNITS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK ARMY TO JAM THE RADIO FREQUENCIES OF THE "OCCUPYING ARMY."

HRADEK KRALOVE RADIO ASKED THE CZECHOSLOVAK ARMY "TO DISTURB THEIR COMMUNICATIONS, AND TO BROADCAST TO THEM, EXPLAINING THE INJUSTICE OF THE OCCUPATION."

THE RADIO ALSO CARRIED APPEALS TO THE SOVIET TROOPS TO WITHDRAW.

MEANWHILE, THE SOVIET CONTROLLED RADIO STATION VLTAVA TODAY URGED CZECHOSLOVAK OFFICERS AND SOLDIERS "TO GIVE ALL COOPERATION AND SUPPORT TO THE ARMIES OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES WHO HAVE ENTERED CZECHOSLOVAK TERRITORY TO DEFEND THE GAINS OF SOCIALISM."

THE RADIO VLTAVA APPEAL EMPHASISED THAT "NOT RPT NOT A MINUTE CAN BE LOST IN THE FACE OF A THREAT OF AN ATTACK BY THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION."

IN OTHER BROADCASTS, CZÉCHOSLOVAK STATIONS APPEALED TO ALL DELEGATES TO THE COMMUNIST PARTY'S EXTRAORDINARY 14TH CONGRESS TO COME TO PRAGUE PREPARED TO HOLD THE CONGRESS.

THE RADIO STATION AT HRADEK KRALOVE ALSO CARRIED BRIEF LOCAL SITUATION REPORTS, FOREIGN NEWS, AND REPORTS OF SUPPORT BY VARIOUS LOCAL GROUPS FOR THE OF PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK.
