PARLIAMENTARIANS ARRESTED (RELEADS CN 127, 2ND ITEM)

NEW DELHI, AUG. 22, REUTER - POLICE ARRESTED 15 MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT, INCLUDING TWO WOMEN, FOLLOWING SCUFFLES AS THEY TRIED TO HAND IN A PROTEST NOTE TO THE SOVIET EMBASSY TODAY, CONDEMNING THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE PROTEST NOTE DEMANDED WITHDRAWAL OF THE "AGGRESSIVE ARMED FORCES." ABOUT 70 M.P.S. WERE INVOLVED IN THE DEMONSTRATION.

PRAGUE DIPLOMATS BACK DUBCEK

GENEVA, AUG. 22, REUTER--CZECHOSLOVAK DIPLOMATS WORKING IN THE UNITED NATIONS TODAY ANNOUNCED UNANIMOUS SUPPORT FOR THEIR COUNTRY'S REFORMIST LEADERS.

A MEETING OF MORE THAN 50 DIPLOMATS, BOTH MEMBERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK MISSION AND OFFICIALS OF THE U.N. AND ITS SPECIALISED AGENCIES, ADOPTED A RESOLUTION WHICH ALSO CONDEMNED THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AS A THREAT TO PEACE.

THEY CALLED FOR AN IMMEDIATE SUMMIT MEETING OF ALL COMMUNIST PARTIES IN PRAGUE.
