X/4 CS - 2ND ADD CEAUSESCU: INTERVENTION (CN 154) XXX SYSTEM

CEAUSESCU ADDED THAT THE MILITARY INTERVENTION "COULD HAVE GRAVE CONSEQUENCES FOR THE DESTINY OF UNITY OF THE SOCIALIST SYSTEM, OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNIST AND WORKERS MOVEMENT, FOR THE PRESTIGE AND INFLUENCE OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, FOR THE POWER OF ATTRACTION OF THE IDEAS OF SOCIALISM, FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE MOVEMENT OF ANTI-IMPERIALIST STRUGGLE AND THE CAUSE OF WORLD PEACE."

HE SAID RUMANIA'S VIEWS (IN CONNECTION WITH CZECHOSLOVAK EVENTS) WERE SHARED BY MANY COMMUNIST AND WORKERS PARTIES, BY THE PROGRESSIVE AND DEMOCRATIC FORCES, BY LARGE WORLD MASSES "WHICH HAVE TAKEN A POSITION OF DISAPPROVAL" OF THE ACTIONS AGAINST CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

HE SAID SUCH ACTIONS HAD AROUSED "AN IMMENSE BITTERNESS IN THE SOULS OF ALL HONEST COMMUNISTS."
