

BELGRADE, AUGUST 22 (UPI)- THE YUGOSLAV COMMUNIST PARTY OFFICIAL ORGAN KOMMUNIST CHARGED TODAY THAT "THE SOVIET UNION IS AFRAID OF DEMOCRACY AT HOME, AND THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA IS A SIGN OF A CRISIS IN THE SOVIET DEVELOPMENT AND SYSTEM."

THE KOMMUNIST EDITORIAL SAID RUSSIAS MOTIVE "OBVIOUSLY IS NOT FEAR FOR THE FATE OF A SOCIALIST REGIME IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, BUT FEAR OF DEMOCRACY IN INTERNAL AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONSM." IT SAID THE "IRRESPONSIBLE ATTACK"

ENDANGERED THE TVEORY AND PRACTICE OF COMMUNISM.

RESORTING TO FORCE, KOMMUNIST SAID, "IS NOT A SIGN OF POWER BUT A SIGN OF WEAKNESS --THE WEAKNESS OFH ARGUMENTS AND POLICIES, A SIGN OF A CRISIS OF ITS OWN DEVELOPMENT AND SYSTEM." IN ITALY, THE MILAN PAPER CORRIERE DELLA SERA SAID:

"MORD THAN EVER (THE EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA) HAVE CONFIRMED THE INCOMPATIBILITY BETWEEN COMMUNISM AND DEMOCRACY, THE ABSOLUTE IMPOSSIBILITY OF A 'THIRD ROAD' BETWEEN FREEDOM AND DICTATORSHIP."
