X/4 C/S - TANJUG CORRESPONDENTS TURNED BACK AT BORDER

MUNICH, AUG 22 (CMD)-- TWO TANJUG JOURNALISTS, ONE OF THEM ACCREDITED TO PRAGUE, TODAY RETURNED TO BUDAPEST AFTER BEING TURNED BACK ON THEIR WAY TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK- HUNGARIAN BORDER.

THIS WAS REPORTED BY THE YUGOSLAV NEWS AGENCY, TANJUG, AND RADIO ZAGREB.

VELIMIR BUDIMIR HAS BEEN TANJUG'S ACCREDITED CORRESPONDENT IN PRAGUE SINCE 1966, BUT SEVERAL DAYS AGO HE WENT TO YUGOSLAVIA FOR A BRIEF VACATION. TANJUG SAID HE HAD ALL THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR CARRYING OUT HIS DUTIES.

THE OTHER TANJUG JOURNALIST WITH BUDIMIR WAS DRAGAN PAVLOVIC.

THE TANJUG CORRESPONDENT IN VIENNA, VLADO BENEDIK WHO ALSO HAS VALID DOCUMENTS, WAS NOT LET INTO CZECHOSLOVAKIA YESTERDAY, TANJUG SAID.
