

X/4 C/S 3RD ADD. 1400 CEAUSESCU SPEECH (CN 225) XXX SAID

THE DECLARATION SAID RELATIONS AMONG THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES SHOULD BE BASED ON THE PRINCIPLES OF MARXISM-LENINISM, OF PROLETARIAN INTERNATIONALISM, ON RESPECT FOR EACH COUNTRY'S INDEPENDENCE AND SOVEREIGNTY, EQUALITY IN RIGHTS, NON-INTERFERENCE, MUTUAL ADVANTAGE AND COMRADELY MUTUAL AID.

IT SAID THIS WAS A "FUNDAMENTAL CONDITION FOR SUCCESSFUL COLLABORATION, FOR STRENGTHENING THEIR POLITICAL AND MILITARY ALLIANCE, FOR STRENGTHENING THEIR UNITY AND COHESION, FOR REMOVING THE EXISTING DIFFERENCES..."

IT SAID THIS "IS THE KEYSTONE OF UNITY AMONG THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, THE MOST IMPERATIVE REQUIREMENT FOR STRENGTHENING THE WORLD SOCIALIST SYSTEM..."

"NOTHING COULD BE MORE DETRIMENTAL TO THE INTERNATIONAL PRESTIGE OF SOCIALISM, TO THE AUTHORITATIVENESS OF THE SOCIALIST STATES ON THE WORLD ARENA, TO THE WORLD INFLUENCE OF COMMUNIST IDEAS THAN VIOLATING THESE PRINCIPLES IN RELATIONS AMONG THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES..."

THE DECLARATION THEN REFERRED TO WHAT IT CALLED THE "USE OF REPROACHABLE METHODS... ARMED INTERVENTION AND MILITARY OCCUPATION..."

RESORTING TO SUCH METHODS WHICH HAVE BEEN LONG CONDEMNED BY THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNIST AND WORKERS MOVEMENT, AND INCRIMINATED AT ITS TIME BY ALL SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, MOST SERIOUSLY PREJUDICES THE REVOLUTIONARY STRUGGLE IN ALL COUNTRIES FOR THE IDEALS OF NATIONAL AND SOCIAL FREEDOM, THE DECLARATION SAID.

IT ADDED: "ONLY THE ELECED BODIES OF A PARTY AND STATE ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DESTINIES OF A SOCIALIST NATION, (ONLY) THEY CAN DECIDE ON WHETHER OR NOT RPT NOT THE CAUSE OF SOCIALISM AND THE PEOPLE'S REVOLUTIONARY ACHIEVEMENTS ARE ENDANGERED, (ONLY THEY) CAN URGE THE POLITICAL, MILITARY OR OTHER AID FROM THE OTHER SOCIALIST COUNTRIES..."

IT SAID THAT "TO APPRECIATE THE SITUATION (EXISTING) IN A SOCIALIST COUNTRY, AND ACT ON THE BASIS OF UNILATERAL, TENDENTIOUS INFORMATION GIVEN BY CERTAIN GROUPS OR PERSONS IS A VIOLATION OF THE SACRED PRINCIPLE OF SOVEREIGNTY OF A SOCIALIST PEOPLE, OF A FRATERNAL COMMUNIST PARTY LEADING THE COUNTRY, AND CREATES A SITUATION ESPECIALLY DANGEROUS TO RELATIONS AMONG THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, TO THE CAUSE OF COLLABORATION AND FRIENDSHIP AMONG PEOPLES..."
