

X/4 C/S - BELGRADE MEETINGS

MUNICH, AUG. 22 (CMD) THE LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS OF BELGRADE TODAY CONDEMNED "WITH DEEP BITTERNESS" THE INTERVENTION OF THE FIVE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, TANJUG REPORTED.

IN A TELEGRAM TO PRESIDENT TITO, THE CITY COMMITTEE OF THE LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS AND THE PRESIDENTIAL COUNCIL OF BELGRADE EMPHASIZED "THE LOATHING OVER THE ACT OF MILITARY AGGRESSION AND THE INDIGNATION OF THE INHABITANTS AND COMMUNISTS OF BELGRADE."

THE TELEGRAM SPOKE OF AN "INCOMPREHENSIBLE ASSAULT ON THE RIGHT OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE TO SOVEREIGNLY DECIDE ON THEIR OWN ROAD TO SOCIALISM," THE TANJUG DISPATCH SAID.

THE TELEGRAM WAS ALSO SIGNED BY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SOCIALIST ALLIANCE, TRADE UNIONS, AND THE YOUTH OF BELGRADE.

TANJUG REPORTED THAT A PROTEST RALLY BY THE CITIZENS OF BELGRADE WAS SCHEDULED FOR 1600 (MT) TODAY, WITH MIJALKO TODOROVIC, SECRETARY OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE YUGOSLAV LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS, EXPECTED TO BE THE PRINCIPAL SPEAKER.

A SESSION OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WAS SCHEDULED FOR 1300 MT TODAY, AND THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS OF YUGOSLAVIA WILL HOLD ITS SESSION TOMORROW. TANJUG SAID "GREAT IMPORTANCE IS ATTACHED TO THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING, WHERE THE LATEST EVENTS WILL BE MORE THOROUGHLY ANALYZED."

THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE SERBIAN COMMUNIST LEAGUE MET EARLIER TODAY, AND A JOINT SESSION OF "ALL THE POLITICAL LEADERSHIPS IN THE YUGOSLAV CONSTITUENT REPUBLIC OF SERBIA" IS SCHEDULED FOR THIS AFTERNOON, TANJUG CONCLUDED.
