C/4 CURT -- CERNIK, OTHERS FLOWN FROM PRAGUE

MUNICH, AUG 22 (CMD) -- RADIO FREE PRAGUE SAID TODAY WITNESSES RECOGNIZED CZECHOSLOVAK PREMIER OLDRICH CERNIK BEING FLOWN FROM PRAGUE AIRPORT TO AN UNKNOWN DESTINATION.

THE RADIO, BREAKING INTO A BROADCAST OF CESKE BUDEJOVICE, ADDED THAT CERNIK "AND OTHER PERSONS" WERE TAKEN TO THE AIRPORT IN A BLACK VOLGA CAR WHICH WAS ACCOMPANIED BY TWO ARMoured TRANSPORT VEHICLES.

(CMD - THE STATION DID NOT IDENTIFY THE NATIONALITY OF THE MILITARY VEHICLES)

"EYEWITNESSES FOUND OUT THAT AN ARMoured TRANSPORT VEHICLE FOLLOWED BY A BLACK VOLGA CAR AND A SMALLER ARMoured VEHICLE ARRIVED AT RUZYNE AIRPORT; CHAIRMAN OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK CABINET GRADUATE ENGINEER OLDRICH CERNIK WAS AMONG THE PEOPLE

SITTING IN THE BLACK VOLGA CAR. HE WAS FLEW TO AN UNKNOWN DESTINATION.

"THE REPORT WAS FILED BY THE WORKERS OF THE RUZYNE AIRPORT," RADIO FREE PRAGUE SAID.
