"IT HAS FOUND THEM OUT AND IT DESPISES AND IS DISGUSTED BY THEIR FURTIVE AND FRADULENT EFFORTS TO DRAPE TYRANNY WITH SANCTIMONY AND ANNOINT IT WITH PIETY."

THE SOVIET DELEGATE SAID HE WOULD LIMIT HIS REPLY UNTIL A LATER MEETING. HE ASSAILED THE "UNFOUNDED AND SLANDEROUS NATURE OF ALL THE SO-CALLED ARGUMENTS THAT HAVE BEEN PRESENTED HERE BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NATO COUNTRIES."

HE SAID THAT NO MATTER HOW MUCH MR. BALL TRIED TO DENY IT "THE MAIN ORCHESTRA LEADER OF THIS REPULSIVE COMEDY" WAS THE U.S. AND HE WOULD NEVER SUCCEED IN HIS DENIALS.

"THE "REPULSIVE COMEDY" HAD ALSO BROUGHT "SECOND-RATE NOW REPRESENTATIVES" IN WITH A "CHORUS OF ANTI-SOVIET SPEECHES," MR. MALIK SAID.

HE SAID THE BRITISH AND OTHER NATO MEMBERS HAD UTTERED "SLANDEROUS FABRICATIONS."

THE COUNCIL ADJOURNED AT 1.26 P.M. (1826 MT) AND AGREED TO MEET AGAIN AT 5 P.M. (2200 MT) THIS AFTERNOON.
