X/4 C/S - VACULIK INFORMS PARTY CONGRESS ON YESTERDAY'S CENTRAL  
COMMITTEE MEETING

MUNICH, AUG 22 (CMD) - CANDIDATE MEMBER OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK  
COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE PRESIDUM MARTIN VACULIK TODAY  
INFORMED THE EXTRAORDINARY 14TH PARTY CONGRESS OF YESTERDAY'S  
MEETING OF ONE THIRD OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS IN PRAGUE'S  
"PRAHA" HOTEL, RADIO FREE PRAGUE REPORTED.

THE RADIO SAID IT WAS CARRYING A RECORDED REPORT OF THE FREE  
RADIO STATION "DANA" FROM THE 14TH CONGRESS OF THE PARTY.

THE REPORT SAID FIRST TO SPEAK AT THE OPENING DAY OF THE CONGRESS  
TODAY WAS VACULIK, WHO "REPORTED ON YESTERDAY'S SESSION OF A PART  
OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE."

THE RADIO SAID "22 MEMBERS OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE MET IN THE  
HOTEL PRAHA IN THE MORNING OF AUGUST 21, AND SEVERAL OTHERS  
CAME IN THE COURSE OF THE MEETING."

THE RADIO WENT ON TO SAY "IN THE EVENING (PRESIDIUM MEMBERS  
DRAHOMIR) KOLDER, (VASIL) BILAK, (FRANTISEK) BARBIREK AND (PARTY  
SECRETARY ALOIS) INDRA CAME TO THE SESSION, BEING PROTECTED BY ARMS  
OF OCCUPANTS."

"THE PRESENCE OF THE SOVIET OFFICERS CHANGED THE PREVIOUS  
STAND OF SOME OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS. VILEM NOVY, KAREL  
MESTEK, MILOS JAKES, ALOIS INDRA, FRANTISEK BARBIREK AND DRAHOMIR  
KOLDER PROVED TO BE COLLABORATORS (OF THE OCCUPANTS,)" THE RADIO  
SAID.

IT WENT ON TO SAY THAT PRESIDUM MEMBER JAN PILLER HAD JOINED  
THE COLLABORATORS.
