THE RADIO SAID PILLER "DEMANDED THAT THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHOULD ADOPT A RESOLUTION IN WHICH IT WOULD DISAGREE WITH THE CONVOCAATION OF THE EXTRAORDINARY CONGRESS, WHICH ALLEGEDLY WOULD SHARPEN THE SITUATION."

THE RADIO SAID "PILLER DEMANDED THAT THE DELEGATES SHOULD BE SENT TO REGIONS AND DISTRICTS TO CALM THE TENSION."

"DESPITE THE PRESENCE OF THE OCCUPATION OFFICERS, NONE OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS WAS ABLE TO CONFIRM THAT ANY ONE, OR A CZECHOSLOVAK ORGAN HAD DEMANDED THE INTERVENTION AND OCCUPATION OF OUR COUNTRY BY THE ARMED FORCES OF THE SIGNATORIES OF THE WARSAW LETTER," THE RADIO SAID.

"JUST BEFORE MIDNIGHT OF AUGUST 20, THE PRESIDIUM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE RECEIVED THE LETTER OF THE SOVIET PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE, IN WHICH THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY WAS ACCUSED OF NOT RPT NOT FOLLOWING THE AGREEMENTS FROM CIERNA, TISOU AND BRATISLAVA."

THE RADIO CONTINUED: "CZECHOSLOVAKIA, ALLEGEDLY, DID NOT RPT NOT STOP POLEMICS, WHICH WERE ALLEGEDLY ON THE CONTRARY, INCREASING."

THE RADIO SAID AS AN EXAMPLE THE WARSAW SIGNATORIES GIVE THE "ORGANIZING OF EXCESSES AT THE OLD TOWN SQUARE AND IN FRONT OF THE BUILDING OF THE PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE ... THE SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE PEOPLE'S MILITIA."
