

## QUIET VIGIL IN LONDON

LONDON, AUG. 22, REUTER - HUNDREDS OF DEMONSTRATORS MAINTAINED A QUIET VIGIL NEAR THE SOVIET AND CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSIES HERE TONIGHT TO PROTEST AGAINST THE SOVIET OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE EMBASSIES ARE ABOUT 100 YARDS (METRES) APART IN A PRIVATE ROAD IN THE WEST LONDON DISTRICT OF KENSINGTON. POLICE GUARDED THE LOCKED IRON GATES LEADING TO THE ROAD AFTER A NOISY ANTI-SOVIET DEMONSTRATIONS THERE LAST NIGHT.

ABOUT TWO MILES (THREE KMS) AWAY, POLICE WERE INVESTIGATING A FIRE AT A SOVIET TRADE EXHIBITION, SCENE OF A DEMONSTRATION BY 2,000 PEOPLE LAST NIGHT. A HALF-EMPTY CAN OF PETROL WAS FOUND NEAR WHERE THE FIRE, QUICKLY BROUGHT UNDER CONTROL, STARTED.

## BRNO CHILDREN'S CHOIR SAFE IN YUGOSLAVIA

MUNICH, AUG 22 (CMD) - THE KANTILENA CHILDRENS CHOIR OF BRNO, CZECHOSLOVAKIA, ARE AT SUTOMORE, A SEASIDE RESORT ON THE ADRIATIC COAST OF YUGOSLAVIA, AND WILL REMAIN THERE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, ACCORDING TO A TANJUG DISPATCH.

THE 80 BOYS AND GIRLS OF THE CHOIR ASKED TANJUG TO SEND THE NEWS TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA, ALONG WITH GREETINGS TO THEIR PARENTS IN BRNO. "WE FEEL COSY AND RECEIVE MANY ATTENTIONS HERE," THE CHILDREN SAID. (TANJUG IN ENGLISH, AUG 22)

## CELTICS DON'T WANT TO PLAY HUNGARIANS

GLASGOW, AUG 22, REUTER - SCOTTISH SOCCER CHAMPIONS CELTIC SAID TONIGHT THEY DID NOT WANT TO PLAY A MATCH AGAINST A HUNGARIAN TEAM BECAUSE OF THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY WARSAW PACT TROOPS.

CELTIC ARE SCHEDULED TO PLAY THE HUNGARIAN SIDE, FERENCVAROS IN BUDAPEST ON SEPTEMBER 18 IN THE FIRST ROUND OF THE EUROPEAN CHAMPIONS CUP.

CELTIC SENT A TELEGRAM TO THE UNION OF EUROPEAN FOOTBALL ASSOCIATIONS SAYING:

"IN VIEW OF THE ILLEGAL AND TREACHEROUS INVASION BY RUSSIAN, POLISH AND HUNGARIAN FORCES OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND IN SUPPORT OF THE CZECH NATION, WE THE CELTIC FOOTBALL CLUB, DO NOT THINK THAT ANY WESTERN EUROPEAN FOOTBALL CLUB SHOULD BE FORCED TO FULFIL ANY COMMITMENT IN THESE COUNTRIES."

## U.S. EVACUATE SOME PRAGUE EMBASSY EMPLOYEES

VIENNA, AUG 22 (RFE SPECIAL/KOCH) - THE U.S. EMBASSY IN VIENNA ANNOUNCED TONIGHT THAT SOME EMPLOYEES AND DEPENDENTS OF THE EMBASSY IN PRAGUE WERE BEING EVACUATED TO AUSTRIA.

THE AMERICAN EVACUEES LEFT PRAGUE AT 1900 MT BY TRAIN AND ARE EXPECTED TO ARRIVE IN VIENNA AT 0200 FRIDAY.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID: "THE EVACUEES SHOULD NUMBER MORE THAN 100 PEOPLE."

HOTEL AND BOARDING HOUSE ACCOMMODATION IS BEING SOUGHT BY THE VIENNA EMBASSY OFFICIALS FOR THE EX-PRAGUE EMBASSY RESIDENTS.
