RADIO BELGRADE SAID DEPUTY FOREIGN SECRETARY MILORAK PESIC MET SEPARATELY WITH THE AMBASSADORS OF THE SOVIET UNION AND POLAND AND THE CHARGES D'AFFAIRES OF EAST GERMANY, BULGARIA AND HUNGARY.

ACCORDING TO THE RADIO, PESIC HANDED OVER TO THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE FIVE COUNTRIES THE YUGOSLAV GOVERNMENT'S STATEMENT IN CONNECTION WITH THE MILITARY INTERVENTION AGAINST CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE RADIO ALSO SAID THAT THE BULGARIAN CHARGE D'AFFAIRS REFUSED TO ACCEPT THE PROTEST NOTE. (RADIO BELGRADE, DOMESTIC/M, AUGUST 22, 1968, 2200)
