C/S - BRUSSELS DEMONSTRATION

BRUSSELS, AUG. 22, REUTER - SEVERAL HUNDRED DEMONSTRATORS, INCLUDING MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT MARCHED THROUGH THE STREETS OF BRUSSELS TONIGHT CHANTING ANTI-RUSSIAN AND PRO-CZECHOSLOVAKIAN SLOGANS.

THE DEMONSTRATORS SAID THEY WOULD CONTINUE THEIR PROTEST WITH AN ALL-NIGHT VIGIL OUTSIDE THE GATES OF THE SOVIET EMBASSY.

IN LUXEMBOURG, TRAFFIC THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY HALTED FOR A MINUTE AND SEVERAL THOUSAND PEOPLE GATHERED IN FRONT OF THE TOWN HALL TO PROTEST AGAINST THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE DEPUTY MAYOR OF LUXEMBOURG, M. LEON BOLLENDORF, AFTER REMINDING THE CROWD THAT LUXEMBOURG AND PRAGUE WERE TWIN CITIES, CALLED FOR TWO MINUTES SILENCE FOR THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE IN FEAR "OF THEIR LIBERTY AND THEIR EXISTENCE."
