THE RADIO SAID "THE COMMUNIQUE CONCLUDES BY CALLING FOR ESTABLISHING CONTACTS WITH THE COMMANDERS OF THE OCCUPATIONAL TROOPS."

THE RADIO SAID "THE COMMUNIQUE TOOK, AS MARTIAN VACULIK STATED, THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AS A REALITY, AND IT TOOK ALSO HOWEVER NOTE OF A SECOND REALITY - THE INDIGNATION AND CLEAR DISAGREEMENT OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK POPULATION WITH THE COURSE OF THE SIGNATORIES OF THE WARSAW LETTER."

THE RADIO SAID APART FROM THE COMMUNIQUE "INSTRUCTIONS WERE TELETYPED TO THE PARTY REGIONAL COMMITTEES WHICH WERE, HOWEVER, DIFFERENT FROM TOPICS OF THE SESSION OF THE ONE THIRD OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE."

"THESE DIRECTIVES," THE RADIO SAID, "WHICH IS IN SHARP CONTRAST TO THE SENSE OF THE COMMUNIQUE, GAVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLLABORATION WITH THE OCCUPIERS."

THE RADIO REPORTED "AFTER VACULIK'S SPEECH, COMRADE HEJZLAR (DIRECTOR OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK LEGAL RADIO) READ THE DRAFT OF A STATEMENT OF THE 14TH CONGRESS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY ON THE CURRENT POLITICAL SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

THE RADIO SAID IN THE DRAFT HEJZLAR READ "THE COURSE OF THE OCCUPIERS IS CONSIDERED AS ILLEGAL." THE DRAFT ALSO DEMANDS "AN IMMEDIATE DEPARTURE OF ALL FOREIGN TROOPS AND UNITS."
