C/S - 1ST ADD - HAJEK IN VIENNA (CN 11) X X X SESSION

(UPI) - HAJEK IS SCHEDULED TO ARRIVE IN NEW YORK FRIDAY AFTERNOON, OFFICIALS AT THE CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY IN WASHINGTON SAID THURSDAY.

THEY SAID THEY DID NOT KNOW WHETHER HE WOULD ADDRESS THE U.N. SECURITY COUNCIL. EARLIER, SECRETARY OF STATE DEAN RUSK TOLD REPORTERS AT THE WHITE HOUSE, "I HAVE SEEN REPORTS THAT HE MAY COME TO THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL. WE CANNOT CONFIRM THAT AT THE MOMENT."

DR. KAREL DUDA, THE CZECHOSLOVAK AMBASSADOR TO THE UNITED STATES, LEFT WASHINGTON (AT 2200 MT) FOR NEW YORK. EMBASSY OFFICIALS SAID THEY DID NOT EXPECT THAT DUDA WOULD ADDRESS THE SECURITY COUNCIL.

"HE WENT TO BE WITH OUR PERMANENT MISSION (TO THE U.N.) AND TO BE THERE FOR THE FOREIGN MINISTER'S VISIT," AN EMBASSY OFFICIAL SAID. HE SAID THE POSSIBILITY OF A VISIT TO WASHINGTON BY HAJEK WAS NOT DISCUSSED.
