PARIS, AUG 23 (UPI) -- THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY THURSDAY NIGHT

THE CONDEMNATION, THE SECOND IN AS MANY DAYS, SAID IT WAS UP TO

NECESSARY TO SAFEGUARD AND DEVELOP SOCIALISM IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

THE SHORT RESOLUTION SAID THE FRENCH PARTY, THE SECOND LARGEST IN WESTERN EUROPE AFTER THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY, WILL NOT RELINQUISH ITS LINKS OF "FRIENDSHIP" WITH THE RUSSIAN COMMUNIST PARTY.
