

X/4 C/S -- 1ST ADD MOSCOW SAYS SOVIET SOLDIERS (CN 74) X X X DUTY.

BOTH OF THE MOSCOW BROADCASTS -- YESTERDAY'S AND TODAY'S
-- WERE BROADCAST TO DOMESTIC SOVIET AUDIENCES. FOLLOWING IS THE
TEXT OF TODAY'S BROADCAST:

"AFTER FLYING INTO THE CZECHOSLOVAK CAPITAL, WE IMMEDIATELY
MET WITH A GROUP OF SOVIET SOLDIERS AND OFFICERS. THE FIRST AND
MOST FUNDAMENTAL IMPRESSION FROM THE TALKS WITH SOLDIERS IS
THEIR CALM AND SELF-RESTRAINT.

"EVERYTHING SHOWS THAT THEY NOURISH MOST SINCERE AND FRIENDLY
FEELINGS TOWARD CZECHOSLOVAK WORKERS. THE SELF-RESTRAINT
WITH WHICH SOVIET SOLDIERS MET INDIVIDUAL EXCESSES, ORGANIZED
WITH PROVOCATIVE AIMS BY ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES, IS ALSO NOTABLE.

"BUT WHILE OBSERVING DISCIPLINE SOVIET SOLDIERS ARE READY
TO OFFER THE MOST CRUSHING RESISTANCE TO DIRECT HOSTILE ACTIONS,
TO ATTACKS ON THE PART OF THE REACTIONARY FORCES. THOSE FORCES ARE
STRIVING BY ALL MEANS TO DISTURB THE NORMAL ATMOSPHERE IN THE CITY.

"HOWEVER, THE PROVOCATIVE SORTIES OF THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION
DO NOT RPT NOT OBTAIN THE SUPPORT OF THE POPULATION. THE FIRST
MEETING WITH PRAGUE, THE FIRST ACQUAINTANCE WITH IT, ESPECIALLY
CLEARLY SHOWED HOW TIMELY AND IMPORTANT WAS THE DECISION OF THE
USSR, POLAND, BULGARIA, HUNGARY, AND THE GDR TO ASSIST THE
CZECHOSLOVAK WORKERS. ONE COULD NOT RPT NOT BE SLOW IN THE
STRUGGLE WITH THE INTRIGUES OF THE INTERNAL AND INTERNATIONAL
