HE ALSO SAID THAT THE U.S. HAD PLENTY OF EXPERIENCE OF JUDASES BECAUSE ITS INTELLIGENCE SERVICE RECRUITED AND TRAINED THEM.

MALIK ALSO CLASHED WITH BRAZILIAN AMBASSADOR JOAO AUGUSTO DE ARAUJO CASTRO, THIS MONTH'S PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL.

AFTER BEING PRESSED SEVERAL TIMES BY MALIK TO ADJOURN THE MEETING WITHOUT A VOTE, CASTRO SAID HE STRONGLY RESENTED "INSINUATIONS" BY THE SOVIET DELEGATE THAT HE WAS ACTING IN THE INTERESTS OF WESTERN POWERS.
