X/4 C/S - BUCHAREST C/S EMBASSY DEMANDS TROOP WITHDRAWAL

MUNICH, AUG 23 (CMD) - WORKERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY IN BUCHAREST HAVE DEMANDED THE "IMMEDIATE WITHDRAWAL OF THE OCCUPYING ARMIES FROM THE TERRITORY OF THE CSSR," RADIO BUCHAREST REPORTED TODAY.

IN A TELEGRAM TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY AND STATE LEADERSHIP THEY ALSO "EXPRESSED SUPPORT TO PRESIDENT SVOBODA, TO THE GOVERNMENT HEADED BY PREMIER CERNIK, TO THE COMMUNIST PARTY HEADED BY DUBCEK, AND DEMANDED THE IMMEDIATE LIBERATION OF THESE COMRADES IN ORDER FOR THEM TO EXERT THEIR FUNCTIONS," THE RADIO SAID.
