X/4 C/S -- RADIO REQUEST TO RUMANIA, YUGOSLAVIA

MUNICH, AUG. 23 -- (CMD) -- A CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO STATION IDENTIFYING ITSELF AS FREE RADIO HRADEC KRALOVE TODAY ASKED RUMANIAN AND YUGOSLAV RADIO STATIONS TO INFORM IN THEIR DOMESTIC AND FOREIGN BROADCAST "THE WHOLE WORLD" ABOUT THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE REQUEST OF THE HRADEC KRALOVE STATION WAS REPORTED BY RADIO BRNO.

THE RADIO SAID THE REQUEST WAS MADE "SO THAT THE WHOLE WORLD MAY KNOW THE TRUTH."

ANOTHER RADIO STATION IDENTIFYING ITSELF AS THE FREE RADIO OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO IN SLOVAKIA CALLED ON HAM OPERATORS TO TURN WITH THE HELP OF THEIR RADIO TRANSMITTERS TO WORLD AGENCIES WITH A REQUEST TO FORWARD AN APPEAL TO LORD BETRAND RUSSEL IN LONDON JEAN-PAUL SARTRE IN PARIS AND VLADIMIR DEDIJER IN BELGRADE.

THE APPEAL SAID THAT WARSAW PACT TROOPS ARE TRAMPLING UNDERFOOT BASIC HUMAN RIGHTS AND VIOLATE ALL INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS.

THE APPEAL CALLED ON THE THREE PERSONALITIES TO CONVOKE AN INTERNATIONAL TRIBUNAL WHICH IN "FACE OF THE WHOLE WORLD WOULD UNEQUIVOCALLY CONDEMN THE BRUTAL AGGRESSION AGAINST CZECHOSLOVAKIAA."
